

LETTER OF AGREEMENT

between the
STATE OF ALASKA

and the
INLANDBOATMEN'S UNION of the PACIFIC, ALASKA REGION
representing the
AMHS UNLICENSED VESSEL EMPLOYEES

Crews of the Alaska Class Ferries during Sea Trials; Terms & Conditions

18-II-174

It is agreed between the parties that the following terms and conditions of employment apply to all employees covered by the Inlandboatmen's Union of the Pacific, Alaska Region. No provision of the July 1, 2014, through June 30, 2017, Master Agreement not specifically referenced herein is modified by this agreement.

The two new Alaska Class ferries, M/V Tazlina (TAZ) and M/V Hubbard (HUB), are being constructed for the State of Alaska at Vigor Alaska in Ketchikan. The completion dates and subsequent acceptance by the State is unknown at this time; however, the State will be conducting sea trials prior to acceptance of either vessel. The following terms and conditions will apply to crews assigned to the vessels during periods of sea trials:

1. The vessels will be crewed in accordance with the Certificate of Inspection issued by the Coast Guard under which the vessel is licensed to operate.
2. Crew members assigned to the vessels will be paid Southeast wages according to Rule 17.01 (A) or (E), as applicable.
3. Crews shall work a forty-two (42) hour workweek. Rule 16.02 will apply. Due to the short duration of the assignment, approximately three weeks, there will be no crew rotations.
4. Assignments to the vessels will be by seniority according to Rule 27. Rule 11 will apply to employees who's primary place of residence is not in Ketchikan.

This agreement is effective upon signature and remains in effect through June 30, 2019. This agreement is entered into solely to address the unique circumstances of the situation and does not establish any practice or precedent between parties. This agreement shall not be referred to in any other dispute, grievance, arbitration, hearing or any other forum, except as may be necessary for the execution of its terms.
